1. DISASTER RELIEF ACTIVITIES

In the year of 2006, different states has also faced such type of devastation, as flood washed away different parts of different stales causing unbearable loss of houses crops and also human lives. UDMRD taught so many people about fire, flood and other disaster.

2. EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES

UDMRD has given equally importance to educational Programme on Printing levels higher levels and Balwarls.

For weak and dropout students UDMRD has arranged remedial coaching for 5 to 7 classes to enable them to compete with other students in normal course and take admission in higher classes of good institutions. Though number is not very high but weak students have developed their studies under the case of competent teacher.

Four Balwaries are working very well with the help of 4 educated Girls and 2 women volunteer.

Regular house to house visits were undertaken to establish communication and their counseling for improving the family and surrounding environment for children growth and development.

150 Children from 1 & ½ were provided matrition and oriented for personnel hygiene and learning while playing together.

3. **HEALTH RELATED ACTIVITIES**

(a) **Pulse Polio Moralization**

Our NGO has organized so many meeting for successful implementation of the Pulse Polio Programme.

(b) **Reproductive and Child Health :**

In rural and remote areas health care mother and child is unknown thing even in urban areas people of working and illiterate class take no measures to protect and health of their families. We started to conduct survey & provide preliminary information on this topic.

(a) **Formulation of SHG**

Under this ochame usually 4 to 6 person mostly women of a locality living below the poverty line from a group with the aim of changing their fate.
